****** DAY AND YEAR END AWARDS ******

Lead Line - Open to all riders 7 years old and under. May be shown English

LL or Western.

Classes: 1, 2, 3, 61

Beginner Walk Trot- Open to all riders 11 years old and under who are competing in

BVT classes independently for the first/second year and **have not won** more than **3 blues** in a prior year. May not cross into any other divisions. May be shown English or Western.

Classes: 4, 5, 6, 62

Walk-Trot 11 & Under Open - Open to all riders 11 years old and under who have

WTU never shown in a canter class. May be shown English or Western.

Classes: 7, 10, 13, 16, 63

Walk-Trot 12-17 Open - Open to all riders 12-17 years old who have never shown

WTO in a canter class. May be shown English or Western.

Classes: 8, 11, 14, 17, 64

Walk-Trot Beginning Canter Open - Open to riders of any age who are competing in

WTBC canter classes for the first / second year, and have not won more than 3 Blues in prior year. Rider cannot ride in any other Canter Class.

May be shown English or Western.

Classes: 9, 12, 15, 18, 65

Open Junior - Open to all riders under 18 years old. May be shown English or Western.

Classes: 19, 23, 27, 31, 35, 68

Open Adult - Open to all riders 18 years or over. May be shown English or Western.

OA **Classes:** 20, 24, 28, 32, 36, 69

Walk-Trot Adult Open - Open to all riders 18 years and older who have never shown

WTA in a canter class. May be shown English or Western.

Classes: 22, 26, 30, 34, 67

Green Horse Walk Trot Open - Open to horses / ponies in their 1st or 2nd year of

GH showing, and not to have won more than 2 blue ribbons in prior years. May be shown English or Western. Horse cannot be shown in any canter classes. May not be ridden by green riders.

Classes: 25, 29, 33, 66

Walk-Trot Hunter: Open to all Hunt Seat riders 11 years old and under who have never

WTH shown in a canter class, and who have not previously jumped over 12" xrails

Classes: 37, 38, 39, 50, 51

Short Stirrup - Open to all Hunt Seat riders 12 years old and under, who have not

******* BHSS RULES AND REGULATIONS *******

1. **Proof of Negative Coggins must be presented with entry -1 years in-state, 6 months out of state.**

2. Any abusive behavior towards any animal will result in dismissal from the show grounds.

3. ASTM-SEI Hard Hats required for all riders under 19 years of age whenever mounted on grounds. Western and Saddle Seat riders will not be penalized for wearing a safety helmet.

4. Shoes or boots with heels must be worn by all riders. Appropriate riding attire will be required.

5. No riding on show grounds bareback, or with halter or lead rope. No riding double.

Flat saddles required for jumping classes.

6. The Show/Manager Committee reserves the right to cancel, divide, or combine classes.

7. Six ribbons will be awarded in all Day / Year End Classes.

8. Horses prone to kicking must wear a red ribbon in their tail. Unruly horses will be asked to leave the show grounds

9. Standard USEF Rules & Regulations will be used as a guideline - Show management decisions are final.

10. All dogs must be on a leash at all times.

11. Ponies are 14.2 hands and under.

12. Horses/Riders are entered at own risk. Felton Field Committee, Barre Horse Show Committee,

BRDC, NEECA, CNEER, and AVPC Organizations are not responsible for any damage to horse, rider, or other properties at the show.

13. There will be no ring work required for Trail Classes. The Trail Course will be set up in a designated area. all competitors must have completed the course by 1:00 PM. **The courses will be posted at the Trail Ring.**

14. Refunds only when due to bona fide injury to horse or rider.

15. Exhibitors must notify Show Announcer of request to Hold a class

16. All ages are determined as of January 1st.

17. Walk-Trot riders may not enter any class calling for a canter.

18. Stallions may be shown only by exhibitors over 21 years old.

19. Chaps are allowed in all Classes except Equitation.

20. No riding on Soccer or Baseball Fields.

21. **Championship Classes** will be judged equally on Equitation, Pleasure, and Suitability of horse / rider combination.

Must show in at least one flat class from same division to enter Champion Class.

22. Only **one** handler is allowed in all In Hand Classes and Lead Line Classes

23. Same horse and rider combination for high point awards, both Day and Year End.

To qualify for Day End pts/awards, same rider and horse combination must show in at least (3) classes in the same division in that show. To qualify for Year End pts / awards, the same rider and horse combination must meet qualifications pts / awards, in at least (3) of the (5) BHSS Shows. In the event of a tie for Day End Award, Showmanship / Model (where applicable) or Equitation, will break the tie.
