

Ring 1 Class Specifications for Judging

<p>GH Green Horse</p>	<p>Open to horses / ponies in their 1st or 2nd year of showing, and not to have won more than 2 blue ribbons in prior years. May be shown English or Western. Horse cannot be shown in any canter classes. May not be ridden by green riders.</p>	<p>Pleasure</p>	<p>The horse must give the appearance of being a safe and suitable pleasure mount. To be shown both directions of the ring at a walk, trot or jog and to stand quietly. The rider is to maintain a light rein but have contact with horse's mouth. Horses may be asked to back. To be judged on performance 60%, conformation and attire 40%. Ribbons 1-6</p>
<p>GH Green Horse</p>	<p>Open to horses / ponies in their 1st or 2nd year of showing, and not to have won more than 2 blue ribbons in prior years. May be shown English or Western. Horse cannot be shown in any canter classes. May not be ridden by green riders.</p>	<p>Discipline Rail</p>	<p>Horses and riders to be judged on their prompt obedience in performing correctly the commands called for by the judge. The execution of the command should start within 3 strides. Only the judge, or his/her appointed assistants, shall eliminate entries. Ribbons 1-6</p>
<p>GH Green Horse</p>	<p>Open to horses / ponies in their 1st or 2nd year of showing, and not to have won more than 2 blue ribbons in prior years. May be shown English or Western. Horse cannot be shown in any canter classes. May not be ridden by green riders.</p>	<p>Championship</p>	<p>To be shown both directions of the ring at a flat walk, trot or jog and to stand quietly. Horses may be asked to back. Championship classes will be judged equally on equitation, pleasure, and suitability of horse and rider combination. Ribbons 1-6.</p>
<p>GH Green Horse</p>	<p>Open to horses / ponies in their 1st or 2nd year of showing, and not to have won more than 2 blue ribbons in prior years. May be shown English or Western. Horse cannot be shown in any canter classes. May not be ridden by green riders.</p>	<p>Trail</p>	<p>Exhibitors must enter the trail area at a walk. To be shown through a course of 6-8 obstacles at a walk or trot. To be scored on the entry's ability to negotiate the entire course efficiently, in a timely manner, without excessive hesitation, with smoothness and style. Ribbons 1-6</p>
