

## RING 1 Class Specifications for judging

<p><b>LL Lead Line</b></p>	<p>Open to all riders 7 years and under. May be shown English or Western. The safety of the exhibitors must be of primary consideration when judging this division. Exhibitors must enter the ring at a walk and must be lead by an experienced adult holding a lead line or rein attached to the halter or bridle. The horse must give the appearance of being a safe mount for this level. (Only one handler to be present in the ring with each rider)</p>	<p><b>Equitation</b></p>	<p>To be judged on the rider's ability only. To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk. The judge may ask each exhibitor to trot or jog a few strides. This would be done individually and in both directions. Ribbons 1-6+</p>
<p><b>LL Lead Line</b></p>	<p>Open to all riders 7 years and under. May be shown English or Western. The safety of the exhibitors must be of primary consideration when judging this division. Exhibitors must enter the ring at a walk and must be lead by an experienced adult holding a lead line or rein attached to the halter or bridle. The horse must give the appearance of being a safe mount for this level. (Only one handler to be present in the ring with each rider)</p>	<p><b>Pleasure</b></p>	<p>The horse must give the appearance of being a safe and obedient pleasure mount for this level. To be shown both ways of the ring at the walk. The judge may ask each exhibitor to trot or jog a few strides. This would be done individually and in both directions. To be judged on performance 60%, conformation and attire 40%. Ribbons 1-6+</p>
<p><b>LL Lead Line</b></p>	<p>Open to all riders 7 years and under. May be shown English or Western. The safety of the exhibitors must be of primary consideration when judging this division. Exhibitors must enter the ring at a walk and must be lead by an experienced adult holding a lead line or rein attached to the halter or bridle. The horse must give the appearance of being a safe mount for this level. (Only one handler to be present in the ring with each rider)</p>	<p><b>Suitability</b></p>	<p>The horse must give the appearance of being a safe, but also suitable, mount for this level. To be shown both ways of the ring at the walk. The judge may ask each exhibitor to trot or jog a few strides. This would be done individually and in both directions. To be judged on suitability and manners 60%, performance and attire 40%. Ribbons 1-6+</p>
<p><b>LL Lead Line</b></p>	<p>Open to all riders 7 years and under. May be shown English or Western. The safety of the exhibitors must be of primary consideration when judging this division. Exhibitors must enter the ring at a walk and must be lead by an experienced adult holding a lead line or rein attached to the halter or bridle. The horse must give the appearance of being a safe mount for this level. (Only one handler to be present in the ring with each rider)</p>	<p><b>Trail</b></p>	<p>Safety of the exhibitors must be of primary consideration when judging this class. Exhibitors must enter the trail area at a walk and must be lead by an experienced adult holding a lead line or rein attached to the halter or bridle. To be shown individually through a course of 6-8 obstacles at a walk only. Obstacle rails must rest flat on the ground. To be scored on the entry's ability to negotiate the entire course efficiently, in a timely manner, without excessive hesitation, with smoothness and style. Ribbons 1-6+</p>
