

Ring 1 Class Specifications for Judging

<p>OA Open Adult</p>	<p>Open to all riders 18 years or over. May be shown English or Western</p>	<p>Model Horse</p>	<p>This class demonstrates the exhibitor's ability to condition and show a horse to a designated person by executing a pattern selected by the judge. The class is to be judged on: Showmanship 60%: 1. Execution of pattern. 2. Posing/Set up for inspection. 3. Poise and alertness of exhibitor. 4. Knowledge of information pertaining to the exhibitor's horse project. Appearance 40%: 1. Cleanliness of horse and rider. 2. Grooming & trimming, 3. Physical condition, 4. Appropriate, clean and properly fitted tack. 5. Appropriate attire of exhibitor.</p>
<p>OA Open Adult</p>	<p>Open to all riders 18 years or over. May be shown English or Western</p>	<p>Equitation</p>	<p>To be judged on the rider's ability only. To be shown at a walk, trot, or canter or jog both ways of the ring. May be asked to perform a simple test. Ribbons 1-6</p>
<p>OA Open Adult</p>	<p>Open to all riders 18 years or over. May be shown English or Western</p>	<p>Pleasure</p>	<p>Open to all ages. To be shown at a flat footed walk, free moving easy two beat trot, and a three-beat canter both ways of the ring on a reasonably loose rein but maintaining contact with the horse's mouth. The judge may call for an extension of gaits. Special emphasis will be placed on a ground-covering walk. Horses may be asked to back. To be judged on performance 60% conformation & attire 40%. Ribbons 1-6 Open to all ages. To be shown at a flat footed walk, free moving easy two beat jog, and a three-beat lope both ways of the ring on a reasonably loose rein but maintaining contact with the horse's mouth. The judge may call for an extension of gaits. Special emphasis will be placed on a ground-covering walk. Horses may be asked to back. To be judged on performance 60% conformation & attire 40%. <p>OA Open Adult</p>	<p>Open to all riders 18 years or over. May be shown English or Western</p>	<p>Discipline Rail</p>	<p>Horses and riders to be judged on their prompt obedience in performing correctly the commands called for by the judge. The execution of the command should start within 3 strides. Only the judge, or his/her appointed assistants, shall eliminate entries. Ribbons 1-6</p>
<p>OA Open Adult</p>	<p>Open to all riders 18 years or over. May be shown English or Western</p>	<p>Championship</p>	<p>To be shown at a flat footed walk, free moving easy two beat jog, and a three-beat lope both ways of the ring on a reasonably loose rein but maintaining contact with the horse's mouth. The judge may call for an extension of gaits. Special emphasis shall be placed on the walk. Horses may be asked to back. Champion classes will be judged equally on equitation, pleasure, and suitability of horse and rider combination. Ribbons 1-6.</p>
<p>OA Open Adult</p>	<p>Open to all riders 18 years or over. May be shown English or Western</p>	<p>Trail</p>	<p>Exhibitors must enter the trail area at a walk. To be shown through a course of 6-8 obstacles at a walk, jog, and lope. To be scored on the entry's ability to negotiate the entire course efficiently, in a timely manner, without excessive hesitation, with smoothness and style. Ribbons 1-6</p>
