<p>WTU Walk-Trot 11&Under</p>	<p>Open to all riders 11 years old and under who have never shown in a canter class. May be shown English or Western. The safety of the exhibitors must be of primary consideration when judging this division. The horse must give the appearance of being a safe and suitable mount. Exhibitors must enter the ring at a walk.</p>	<p>Equitation</p>	<p>To be judged on the rider's ability only. To be shown both directions of the ring at a flat walk, trot or jog and to stand quietly. . The rider is to maintain a light rein, but have contact with the horse's mouth. Horses will not be asked to back. For safety, the judge may request one attendant per horse to stand near their entry during the line up. Ribbons 1-6</p>
<p>WTU Walk-Trot 11&Under</p>	<p>Open to all riders 11 years old and under who have never shown in a canter class. May be shown English or Western. The safety of the exhibitors must be of primary consideration when judging this division. The horse must give the appearance of being a safe and suitable mount. Exhibitors must enter the ring at a walk.</p>	<p>Pleasure</p>	<p>The safety of the exhibitors must be of primary consideration when judging this class. Exhibitors must enter the ring at a walk. The horse must give the appearance of being a safe and suitable pleasure mount. To be shown both directions of the ring at a flat walk, trot or jog and to stand quietly. The rider is to maintain a light rein but have contact with horse's mouth. For safety, the judge may request one attendant per horse to stand near their entry during the line up. To be judged on performance 60%, conformation and attire 40%. Ribbons 1-6</p>
<p>WTU Walk-Trot 11&Under</p>	<p>Open to all riders 11 years old and under who have never shown in a canter class. May be shown English or Western. The safety of the exhibitors must be of primary consideration when judging this division. The horse must give the appearance of being a safe and suitable mount. Exhibitors must enter the ring at a walk.</p>	<p>Discipline Rail</p>	<p>Horses and riders to be judged on their prompt obedience in performing correctly, the commands called for by the judge. Horses will not be asked to back. The execution of the command should start within 3 strides. Only the judge, or his/her appointed assistants, shall eliminate entries. Ribbons 1-6</p>
<p>WTU Walk-Trot 11&Under</p>	<p>Open to all riders 11 years old and under who have never shown in a canter class. May be shown English or Western. The safety of the exhibitors must be of primary consideration when judging this division. The horse must give the appearance of being a safe and suitable mount. Exhibitors must enter the ring at a walk.</p>	<p>Championship</p>	<p>To be shown both directions of the ring at a flat walk, trot or jog and to stand quietly. Horses will not be asked to back. Championship classes will be judged equally on equitation, pleasure, and suitability of horse and rider combination. For safety, the judge may request one attendant per horse to stand near their entry during the line up.</p>
<p>WTU Walk-Trot 11&Under</p>	<p>Open to all riders 11 years old and under who have never shown in a canter class. May be shown English or Western. The safety of the exhibitors must be of primary consideration when judging this division. The horse must give the appearance of being a safe and suitable mount. Exhibitors must enter the ring at a walk.</p>	<p>Trail</p>	<p>Exhibitors must enter the trail area at a walk. To be shown through a course of 6-8 obstacles at a walk or trot. Obstacle rails must be rest flat on the ground. To be scored on the entry's ability to negotiate the entire course efficiently, in a timely manner, without excessive hesitation, with smoothness and style. Ribbons 1-6</p>
