

RING 1 Class Specifications for judging

WTBC Walk-Trot Beginning Canter	<p>Open to riders of any age who are competing in canter classes for the first / second year, and have not won more than 3 Blues in prior year. Rider cannot ride in any other Canter Class. May be shown English or Western.</p>	Equitation	<p>The safety of the exhibitors must be of primary consideration when judging this class and judge is to use discretion on the number of riders to canter at one time. Exhibitors must enter the ring at a walk. To be judged on the rider's ability only. To be shown both directions of the ring at a flat walk, trot or jog, canter or lope, and to stand quietly. The rider is to maintain a light rein but have contact with horse's mouth. Horses will not be asked to back For safety, the judge may request one attendant per horse to stand near their entry during the line up. Ribbons 1-6</p>
WTBC Walk-Trot Beginning Canter	<p>Open to riders of any age who are competing in canter classes for the first / second year, and have not won more than 3 Blues in prior year. Rider cannot ride in any other Canter Class. May be shown English or Western.</p>	Pleasure	<p>The horse must give the appearance of being a safe and suitable pleasure mount. To be shown both directions of the ring at a flat walk, trot or jog, canter or lope, and to stand quietly. The rider is to maintain a light rein but have contact with horse's mouth. To be judged on performance 60%, conformation and attire 40%. Ribbons 1-6</p>
WTBC Walk-Trot Beginning Canter	<p>Open to riders of any age who are competing in canter classes for the first / second year, and have not won more than 3 Blues in prior year. Rider cannot ride in any other Canter Class. May be shown English or Western.</p>	Discipline Rail	<p>Horses and riders to be judged on their prompt obedience in performing correctly, the commands called for by the judge. The execution of the command should start within 3 strides. Only the judge, or his/her appointed assistants, shall eliminate entries. Ribbons 1-6</p>
WTBC Walk-Trot Beginning Canter	<p>Open to riders of any age who are competing in canter classes for the first / second year, and have not won more than 3 Blues in prior year. Rider cannot ride in any other Canter Class. May be shown English or Western.</p>	Championship	<p>To be shown both directions of the ring at a flat walk, trot or jog, canter or lope, and to stand quietly. Championship classes will be judged equally on equitation, pleasure, and suitability of horse and rider combination. For safety, the judge may request one attendant per horse to stand near their entry during the line up. Ribbons 1-6</p>
WTBC Walk-Trot Beginning Canter	<p>Open to riders of any age who are competing in canter classes for the first / second year, and have not won more than 3 Blues in prior year. Rider cannot ride in any other Canter Class. May be shown English or Western.</p>	Trail	<p>The safety of the exhibitors must be of primary consideration when judging this class. Exhibitors must enter the trail area at a walk. To be shown through a course of 6-8 obstacles at a walk, trot or jog, and canter or lope. Obstacle rails must rest flat on the ground. To be scored on the entry's ability to negotiate the entire course efficiently, in a timely manner, without excessive hesitation, with smoothness and style. Ribbons 1-6</p>
